Primary Sports, Clubs and Activities

At Derby High Primary, a wide range of extra-curricular sports, clubs and activities are available to children. Some might only be offered to a specific year group(s) while some might have to be more selective due to limited numbers.

Y3-6 Junior Sports Clubs (Autumn Term = Netball, Football, Tag Rugby, Hockey – these are in bold on the Autumn Timetable)

- A sign-up sheet will be on the Sports Notice Board for children to display their interest in attending the after-school club.
- Children will sign up and take a letter. They will need to return the permission slip to the Sports Notice Board **by Monday 6th September**.
- The first session will be a trial. An 'invitation' will then be sent to selected students' Parents via HighPost to begin the club properly from **Monday 13th September**.
- **ONLY** these children will continue to attend the club, as long as parents/carers have replied to the HighPost invitation.

After School Clubs

Other after school clubs will require permission BEFORE the day the club begins. This allows the organising teacher the time to plan and organise fun and exciting clubs for the children. Most clubs will aim to begin the first full week of term (from Monday 6th September). You will either receive a paper letter from the organising teacher or a HighPost to your email address. A permission slip should then be returned to school ASAP or a reply to the HighPost correspondence to confirm a place at the club.

Lunchtime Clubs

Lunchtime clubs can be flexible. Most teachers will inform children when they begin and ask the children to 'sign up' to attend. In the infants, this might come as a message from home, or from the children themselves, while in the Juniors, children usually let the teachers know. Teachers ask for a commitment from the children to attend the club for the duration of the term. If a child does not wish to continue with the respective club, they should speak to the teacher in charge and explain this so the teacher knows why they do not wish to continue. Some teachers may still send a letter home with any additional information about the club they are running, but this is not the case for all lunchtime clubs.

Music Clubs

Mrs Cooke will explain how these will run this term. Some clubs will be open to all, while others will be chosen according to musical instruments played and ability.

Externally Run Clubs

If your child attends clubs that are organised by a non-member of staff, parents should speak directly to this organiser regarding cost and other requirements and information.
